### **INFORMATION FOR ALL THOSE ENTERING THE EXHIBITION**

**ENTRIES** There are 6 categories.

1. Chairman's challenge "Horizons"
2. Chairman's challenge "In the bag"
3. Bed Quilts
4. Wall Quilts
5. Other items - e.g. cushions, bags etc
6. Quilts for Balloons

Entries are limited to three **finished** items per person for categories 3 to 5 **plus** both the Chairman's challenges and Balloons quilts.

**HANGING FEE.** Each quilt/item is subject to a hanging fee to cover the cost of insurance. Please be realistic with your valuation, which must not include VAT.

£1.00 for articles valued up to £125

£1.50 for articles valued at £126 - £350

If you have a quilt which you consider to be worth more than £1,000 you will need to arrange your own insurance.

**HANGING** All quilts **must** have a secure 4 inch hanging sleeve sewn to the top of the quilt, except miniature quilts, Balloons quilts, Horizons challenge and "other items"

**ENTRY FORMS** Please make sure that the title you give on the entry form is the same as that put on the quilt label. I suggest you make a note of your entries on the reverse of this information sheet or photocopy the form.

Please give techniques used i.e. hand applique, machine quilted and where you got the idea i.e. started at a workshop, quilt seen in a magazine/show, a photo or fabric.

Give a short sentence that tells the viewer why you made the quilt.

**Entry forms received after the cut off date of July 16th will not be accepted.**

**LABELLING and QUILT DELIVERY** Clear polythene bags with blank sticky labels for your quilt and bag will be available at the June and July meetings, and on delivery at show. When you receive your bag, label it at the bottom with your name and the name of the quilt. Do the same for the quilt firmly attaching it to the bottom left corner on the reverse. We will add the quilt number when you deliver it. Fold the quilt inside out so that the label is visible through the bag. Label other items somewhere convenient such as inside a bag.
