

Miniature Log Cabin Workshop with Joy Salvage (Patchwork Joy)

You will learn how to make miniature Log Cabin blocks using a simple strip piecing method. There are lots of tricks and tips shared along with Joy's exact process, which is explained and demonstrated. Handouts are also included so quilters can take these away with them.

There are no special requirements or fancy tools needed, and the technique is a great one to use up the 'stash'. Fat quarters or scraps work perfectly! The technique is done using a sewing machine.

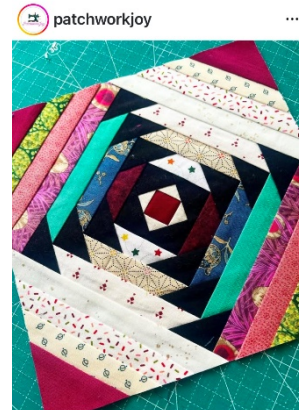
When: Thursday 27th March 10am – 4pm

What to bring:

- sewing machine with quarter inch foot if you have one
- sewing supplies, cutting mat, ruler and rotary cutter, unpicker, thread, needles etc
- fabric - any scrap bigger than 1 inch x 4 inches will work, fat quarters work well, you will need a minimum of three fabrics, one light, one dark and something contrasting for the middle e.g. cream, navy and then red for the middle. If in doubt bring what you think might work and we will decide on the day.
